Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I wanted to update you on our upcoming 2020 Deliverance Conference next month. We are indeed moving forward safely with preparations. Our speakers, including Bishop Sheridan and myself, are very excited to see you soon. Because we are filming the conference, we won't be able to livestream it at the same time. We hope to sell CDs during the conference of each speaker's talks and the DVD version within 3 months after that. We hope to offer a special Mass of Reparation for the healing of generations on Thursday morning so please prepare and bring your family trees paperwork. This year we will have worship each day with music provided by Angie Myers. Our MNE Prayer Team will also be offering Soaking Prayer for those who come.

We figure to have about 125 participants this year and so we will be seating 3 people per round table in the conference room for safe distancing. We'll provide masks if you should choose to wear one. All meals will be served in boxes instead of cafeteria style. You're welcome to eat in the cafeteria or outside under the beautiful mountains. Registration and breakfast will be from 7:30 to 8:15am each morning. The first talk begins at 8:30am in Assisi Hall. We'll also provide a hearty lunch and afternoon snack, but dinner will be on your own. Our hope is to offer Prayer Ministry at 4:45pm on Tuesday and Wednesday with the doors closing at 6:30pm so that you can go out for some Colorado dining. On Thursday, we will conclude with lunch at 12:30pm.

Once again, we have some very exciting topic materials to cover this year. Monica Hernandez will be sharing with us the good news about Healing of the Heart Ministry and what that looks like. Fr. Dennis McManus will be sharing his perspective as an Exorcist on how evil spirits enter and how to get rid of them. Susan Brinkman will be exposing more New Age and Occult Practices so that we can recognize them and defend our families from the enemy. I will be covering the topic of our authority in Christ as believers, as well as teaching practical steps in cleansing a house of poltergeists and a few other topics. Please be sure to check in Tuesday at the upstairs registration booth at 7:30am to pick up your name badge, conference schedule, Level 3 Deliverance Manual and Kathleen Beckman's DVD from last year's conference. It might be helpful to bring your personal hand sanitizer or wipes, face mask, Bible, Rosary, pen and notepad.
