## FLIGHT RECOMMENDATIONS

This year's Conference is held in the **Infinity Conference Center at Holiday Inn North in Longview, Texas**. This event is closer to the Shreveport Regional Airport in Shreveport, Louisiana which is only 60 miles away by car and is serviced by four airlines:

Allegiant, American, Delta and United. Tyler Pounds Airport is 30 minutes away from the Holiday Inn and is serviced by American Airlines with two daily flights. Dallas Love Field or Dallas/Fort Worth Airports are 150 miles away by car. There is no shuttle service to our event so please make travel arrangements.

**Pope John Paul II; Mission of the Redeemer**

“The liberation and salvation brought by the kingdom of God come to the human person both in his physical and spiritual dimensions. Two gestures are characteristic of Jesus’ mission: healing and forgiving. Jesus’ many healings clearly show his great compassion in the face of human distress, but they also signify that in the kingdom there will no longer be sickness or suffering, and that his mission, from the very beginning, is meant to free people from these evils. In Jesus’ eyes, healings are also a sign of spiritual salvation, namely liberation from sin.

By performing acts of healing, he invites people to faith, conversion, and the desire for forgiveness... The acts of liberation from demonic possession, the supreme evil and symbol of sin and rebellion against God, are signs that indeed “the kingdom of God has come upon you.”

**Bishop Joseph Strickland** was appointed by Pope Benedict XVI as the Fourth Bishop of the Diocese of Tyler in September of 2012. Bishop Strickland is one of the Church’s boldest and most courageous leaders. His outspoken support of orthodox faith and morals, the sanctity of unborn life, and reforming Catholic institutions have made him a hero even to Catholics outside his little East Texas diocese. He is author of the recent book, *Light and Leaven: The Challenge of the Laity in the 21st Century*, from Catholic Answers Press. Also Bishop Strickland’s valuable insights and constructive counsel reach a national audience weekly on *The Bishop Strickland Hour* – hosted by Virgin Most Powerful Radio.



**Fr. Greg Bramlage** is the President and Founder of Missionaries of the New Evangelization, an international apostolate of prayer and teaching in Evangelization and Deliverance Ministry. He has evangelized at Parish Missions and Conferences throughout the U.S., Africa, India, Central and South America.
